

A Lions Clubs International Hunger District Coordinator is responsible for leading and coordinating hunger relief initiatives within their designated district, working to raise awareness about food insecurity, mobilizing Lions clubs to participate in hunger projects, secure funding, and oversee the distribution of food and resources to those in need, all while aligning with the organization's broader hunger relief goals and strategies.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Awareness Building:**
 - Educate Lions clubs within the district about the scope of hunger issues in the community.
 - Promote Lions Clubs International's hunger initiatives and programs to clubs and members.
 - Organize awareness campaigns and presentations to highlight the need for hunger relief efforts.
- **Project Development and Implementation:**
 - Facilitate the development of hunger-focused service projects at the club level, including food drives, community meals, and food distribution programs.
 - Encourage collaboration with local food banks, shelters, and other community organizations to maximize impact.
 - Monitor project progress and ensure alignment with district-wide hunger goals.
- **Fundraising and Grant Management:**
 - Coordinate fundraising efforts within the district to support hunger relief initiatives.
 - Apply for Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) grants to fund large-scale hunger projects.

- Share success stories and impact reports with Lions Clubs International and district members.

Required Skills and Qualifications:

- Strong leadership and organizational skills with the ability to motivate others
- Passion for community service and addressing hunger issues
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills to build relationships with clubs and community partners
- Experience in project management and fundraising
- Familiarity with Lions Clubs International policies and procedures
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team

Note: Specific responsibilities may vary depending on the district's needs and the Lions Clubs International strategic priorities related to hunger relief.
